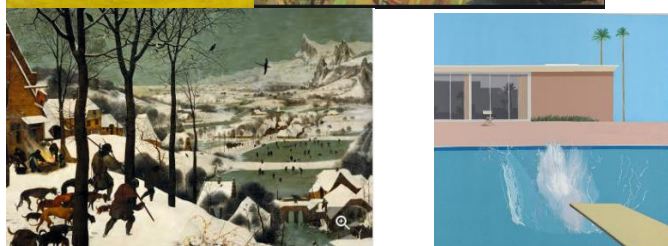
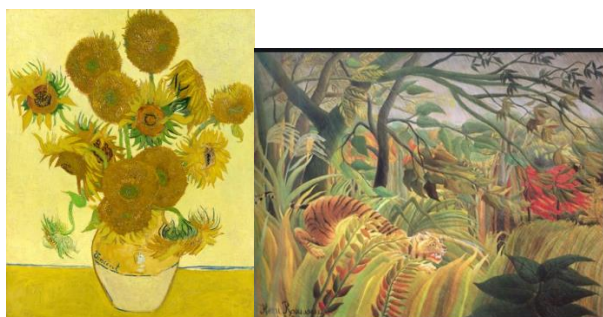




What we will be studying ...

Autumn 1 Cycle A



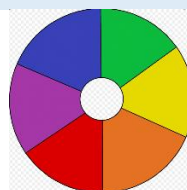
This half term we will be looking at colour and line in art and in the natural world around us. We will be exploring how it makes us feel and how it can change our mood.

We will be looking at some of the work of Vincent Van Gogh who was a prolific painter and used colour to great effect. We will be looking at Henry Rousseau's 'Surprised' and asking why he used the colours that he did.

Pieter Breugel's 'Hunters in the snow' brilliantly shows cool colours and we will be looking at that and comparing it to David Hockney's 'A Bigger Splash'.

We will look at how to make secondary colours and will create our own colour wheel.

We will start to explore how lines are all around us and we can use them to add realism to our drawings.
