Accelerated Reader

This year we implemented Accelerated Reader in school which is a reading scheme for children to access once they have read a book. The children in Key Stage 2 and Year 2 have been accessing this, once they have read a book they complete a quiz. This supports the children with their comprehension skills. Next week the children will be asked to complete a questionnaire regarding reading and the Accelerated Reader programme as we are interested in gaining their views. A questionnaire will be posted in their Google Classroom on Wednesday 1st July for your child to complete if they are in years 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6.
