Applications for Reception:

If you have not already submitted an application for your child for entry into Primary/infant school in September 2021, please note that applications must be completed and returned to the Admissions Team by the closing date of the 15 January 2021. There are two ways to make your application. It can be done either:

- Online via the website <u>www.cambridgeshire.gov.uk</u> /admissions
- On a paper application available by calling 0345 045 1370. Please note that if you apply on paper, you will need to wait for your postal offer, and will not receive an email on the offer date.

Please also note that if your child has an EHCP you should contact the Student Assessment Team (SAT team) on 01480 372600.

Any applications made after the 15th January 2021 will be considered as a late application. These applications will be considered in May 2021, once all the "on time" applications have been offered places, so it is very important to apply by the closing date

Change of footwear:

In order to ensure that all the children are able to get outside at break and lunchtime we will continue to use the field. As it is getting muddier on the field, children can bring in a change of footwear (welly boots) for use outside.

Parking in and around the school

Please continue to avoid parking outside the school and use the church car-park when bringing and collecting your children from school. We want our children to be safe.
