If there other activities you are doing as a family, that is absolutely fine, but a weekly interaction would be great so that we know the children are ok.

Instagram

We are setting up an Instagram account where parents can share photos of their children doing their home learning activities. This is entirely optional and photos must come from a parent, not a child. If you have photos of your children learning from home then please send them to instagram@fenstanton.cambs.sch.uk this is monitored by our staff. Your photos will then make their way to our Instagram account – if you want to follow, please do at ‘fenhilp’. Please note that we will only accept adult followers whom we know belong to a child so if you have an obscure handle it might be time to change it!
