## Geography

We will learn to understand the geographical similarities and differences through studying the human and physical geography of East Anglia and Eastern Australia as a contrasting non-European country. We will use world maps, atlases and globes to identify these locations.



#### Computing

Explore how technology can be used to create art work.

The children will create their own aboriginal artwork on the computer using a program called Tizzy's tools.

#### Maths:

Multiplication & Division – using objects and pictures to solve multiplication and division problems. Fractions – finding ½ of shapes and amounts.

**Measures** – **Time**, telling the time to the hour and half hour. Sequence events in chronological order.

Length & Height, choose and use appropriate non-standard units to estimate and measure length/height. Geometry – describe position, direction and movement, including whole, half, quarter and three-quarter turns.

## Science

Animals including Humans We will identify and name a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals. We will identify and name a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.
