## Message from the Head...

Dear parents and carers,

Our children in Year 1 – Year 6 have been focused on their assessments in classrooms this week. This has included work on reading and phonics; spelling; punctuation and grammar; and maths. For our Year 6 pupils, this is the final round of assessments before they complete the SATs during week beginning May 11<sup>th</sup>.

We have been able to use our large field on a few occasions this week, which has provided more space for games and activities during lunchtime. A small number of pupils have shown behaviour, language and interactions that have been antisocial and we had sought to address this where necessary. There have been giant Jenga blocks thrown, with a head injury caused, along with swear words used, broken resources from acts of violence, and children seemingly attempting to destroy trees by tearing smaller branches from them. Sometimes children have a tendency to behave differently in school than they might do at home, where the ratios of adults to children are likely to be significantly different. We are always grateful for the support of parents when we are responding to behaviours in school.

Young Carers Action Day was on Wednesday this week. Mrs Dino led an assembly with our children and there is a flyer for your information attached with this newsletter. Our children from Reception – Year 6 will be part of *Speak Out. Stay Safe.* assemblies on Monday next week, using resources from the NSPCC. They will also be part of some follow-up activities throughout the week, as per the communication shared with parents on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> March.

Children in Year 3 and 4 are off to Flag Fen next Tuesday. Pupils should wear full school uniform and sensible, comfortable footwear to be outside in. Children will also need to bring a coat, a packed lunch and a water bottle.
