Message from the Head...

Dear parents and carers,

We are very proud of the children who have been taking Phonics Screening assessments this week. Miss Briggs and Mrs Veitch have been administering these to all of our Year 1 children, and to some of our Year 2 pupils. An early look at the data suggests that the children have performed very well in the assessments. This is pleasing news for our school data, of course, but more importantly it is fantastic that so many of our children are doing so well with their early reading. We also completed the administration of the Multiplication Tables Check with Year 4 children at the start of this week. This tests the children's recall of multiplication facts, up to 12 X 12.

Our Reception Class enjoyed their trip to Shepreth Wildlife Park on Wednesday. Back in the classroom, Mrs Wilkins has been using the memories of the trip to inspire the children's writing. I have seen some fabulous sentences in the children's writing books today. I am sure our Good Level of Development outcomes in Reception will be just as impressive as those phonics scores in Year 1!

Next week will be our 'Art Week' across school. The children have been invited to provide artwork for our exhibition next Thursday. As per our communication from Friday 22nd May, children's artwork should be on the theme of 'Our World' and brought into school by next Wednesday, 17th June. You are invited to attend the exhibition of work in the hall at 3.30pm next Thursday afternoon.

We are grateful to our PTA team, who have approved funding for new reading books; resources for our Early Years outdoor areas; new go-karts for the playground; and money to support a visit from the PSHE Service's Life Education Bus next spring. The hard work of the team is almost-constant. The PTA have been in school this week leading Father's Day present rooms; next week there will be another present room and the FenHil Festival next Friday afternoon. We are also grateful to our partners at Teaching Personnel, who have donated four scooters for the children to use as part of our 'play shed' offer on a Wednesday lunchtime.
