## Message from the Head...

I hope you have all had a positive week! Perhaps you have been considering the recent letter from our Chair of Governors, regarding a role as a parent governor. We would love to talk to you about this if you have an interest. We are sure many of you have the skills to be excellent school governors and join the supportive team we already have. We cannot operate our school without a governing body, of course, so I would be delighted to talk about this if you would like to know more about what is involved.

I had a positive conversation with a parent this week regarding PE kit, and the recent changes that mean children wear their kits to school on PE days.
